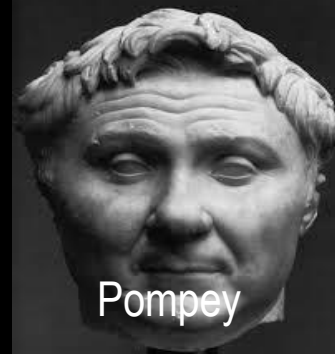

Pictured: Map of the Italian Peninsula in Ancient Roman Times



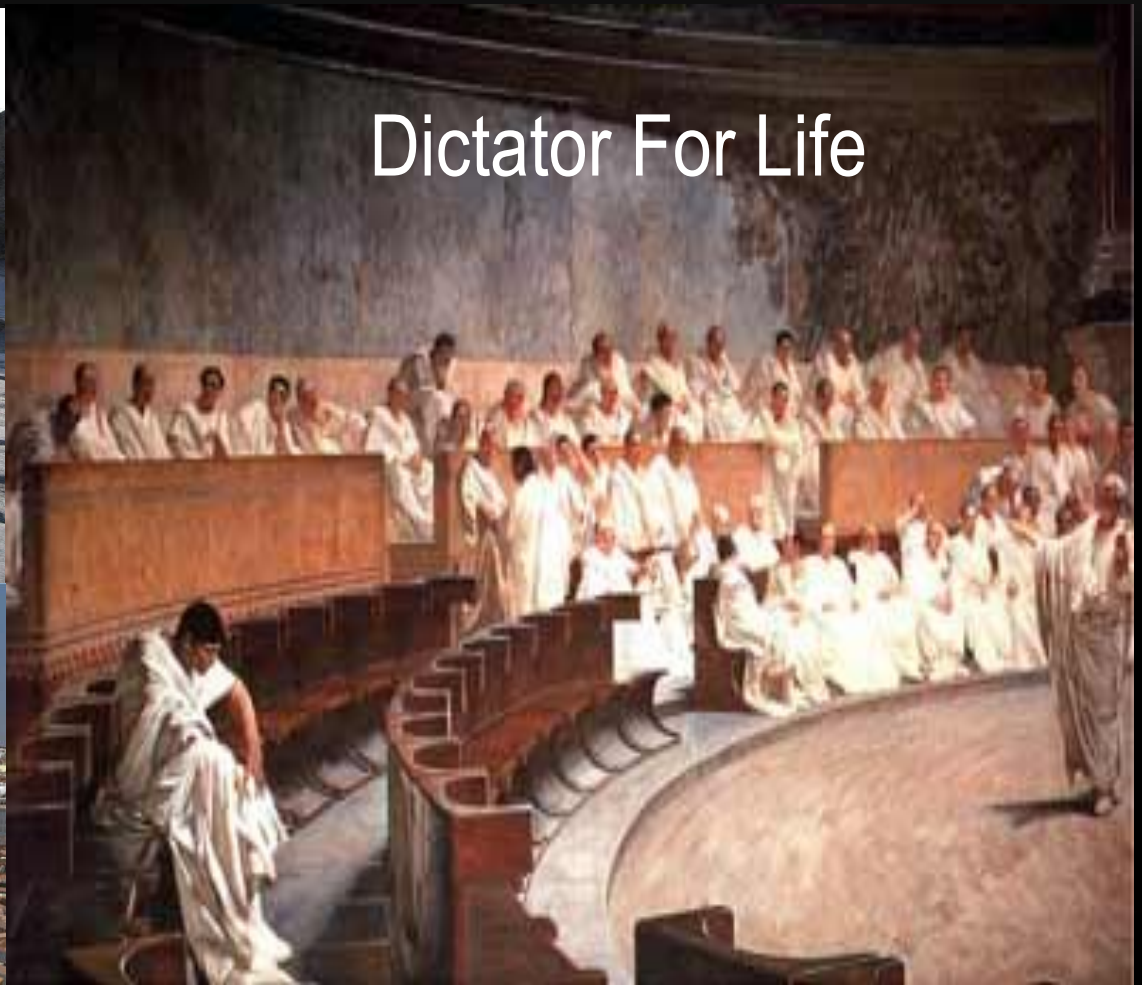

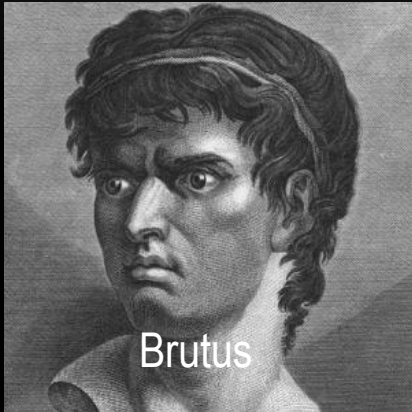
